- Posters must be on a standard 22-inch by 28-inch poster board. Any art method is permitted on the board.
- Please follow the theme "Ways we all do our part to protect our waterways and sea animals that inhabit".
- The student's name, teacher's name and school must be printed neatly in the lower right-hand corner on the back of the poster.
- Please contact the Division at 732-592-9067 to arrange drop off of the posters.
- Prizes will be awarded for the first, second and third place winners in each grade.
- First Place Prize will be Family of 5 Pack to the Boardwalk. It includes the aquarium, rides, beach, funhouse and mini golf
- Second Place Prize will be for a Private Behind the Scenes Tour of the Aquarium for 4 people.
- Third Place Prize will be an Animal Adoption of their choice from our website, www.jenkinsons.com/aquarium
- Each winner will also receive a prize bag from the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary including a Challenge Coin.
- The deadline for submission is Saturday, May 24. Winners will be notified and announced at a later date.
